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Tracking Tool

There are now two ways to track your learning. The **Record of Learning** is an online tool in your College of Licensed Practical Nurses of Alberta (CLPNA) member profile that can be used to document and record all continuing education and learning activities you complete any time during the year . If you prefer to record your learning on a paper form, the **Record of Professionals Activities** document is on page 6 and 7. Both Records will help you with record keeping and completion of your Learning Plan. You can also develop your own method of tracking. You only need to use **ONE method** of tracking. Remember: It doesn't matter how you track, it only matters that you do.

It is suggested you maintain a Record on an ongoing basis keeping certificates, summaries and other documents in a "Professional Portfolio" for easy reference. Your Professional Portfolio is useful in maintaining records of your continued learning throughout your career. The Portfolio can be useful in job interviews to share your competencies with perspective employers and discuss what additional education you have accessed throughout your career. If you are randomly selected for annual Continuing Competency Program Validation (CCPV), this information will be required to verify completion of your learning objectives in your learning plan and to demonstrate your participation in CLPNA's Continuing Competency Program.

How to Use the Online Record of Learning Tool

Complete all fields to record the continuing education and learning activities that you have undertaken in the past year.

- a. **LEARNING ACTIVITY** – Describes the continuing education you completed. Use a title that you will easily remember in future (i.e. communication, pharmacology, diabetes, etc.).
- b. **REGISTRATION YEAR** – The year the learning was completed.
- c. **LEARNING OBJECTIVE/COMPETENCY CODE/STATEMENT** – (from Competency Profile) Select the code from the drop down menu that relates to completed learning activity.
- d. **RESOURCES/STRATEGIES USED** – Select the code that describes the resources/strategies used to achieve learning.
- e. **MONTH COMPLETED** – Select the code for the month the learning took place.
- f. **TRANSFER OF LEARNING** – Select the code that best indicates how you changed your thinking as you completed the learning objective. Measure the increase in your nursing knowledge before and after completion of the learning.

g. IMPACT ON PRACTICE – Select the code that defines how you applied the learning and changed your on-the-job behavior because of the completed learning objective. Consider how you will implement this learning back into your nursing practice. This can be immediate or may occur several months after continuing education.

h. SUMMARY OF LEARNING – Summary of learning validates how your thinking and behavior as a professional nurse has changed. It also confirms how completion of the learning objective(s) has enhanced your nursing practice. Provide a detailed *evaluation* of your learning. Explain and give example(s) of how your completed learning has influenced, impacted and enhanced your practice. Why did you choose this learning objective? What did you learn? How has the learning changed the way you think and behave in your practice? How will the learning affect your practice in the future? If you partially complete a learning objective, reflect on these questions based on the learning you completed in the year you are reporting.

Complete all of the fields to record the continuing education and learning activities you have undertaken in the past year.

How to Keep a Record of Professional Activities

The Record of Professional Activities is another tool that you can use to document and record all continuing education and learning activities. Complete all four columns to record the continuing education and learning activities that you have undertaken in the past year.

- a. **Date** learning was completed.
- b. **Competency Code** of learning objective that relates to completed learning activity, using the Competency Profile
- c. **Resources/Strategies** used for all activities you have undertaken to maintain competence and to enhance your learning and performance in the past year
- d. **Summary of Learning** validates how your thinking and behavior as a professional nurse has changed. It also confirms how completion of the learning objective(s) has enhanced your nursing practice. Provide a detailed *evaluation* of your learning. Explain and give example(s) of how your completed learning has influenced, impacted and enhanced your practice. Why did you choose this learning objective? What did you learn? How has the learning changed the way you think and behave in your practice? How will the learning affect your practice in the future? If you partially complete a learning objective, reflect on these questions based on the learning you completed in the year you are reporting.
